


MAY 2019 - MY MONTH OF DIVINE FAVOR

Psalm 30:5 (KJV) "For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning."

Psalm 8:12 (KJV) - "For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield." I welcome you to May 2019 - your month of Divine Favor.

The Bible says in Psalm 5:12 (KJV), "For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield." It is seen here that God is willing to bless the righteous and also protect him with the weapon of favour. When the favor of God is upon a man, he will be secured and protected against all oppositions and anti-favour moves of men.

The word Divine means to emanate from God; favor on the other hand, means an advantage to the benefit of someone or something. Divine Favor is therefore God putting us in a position or giving us something we have not worked for ourselves. When a man is selected for something good among many qualified counterparts. For instance, Esther was selected among several other beautiful ladies that are qualified to be the queen. Esther 2: 15-17. When a man is chosen for the position he is not naturally qualified for, especially among others that are far better than him. David was the most unqualified person naturally in his family, but God rejected others to look for him. 1 Samuel 16: 11-13. When a man seeks the face of God in Prayer, and have all his request granted. A very good example is the account of Jabez. 1 Chron 4: 9-10. When a man is always receiving kindness from others as a result of God's hand on his life. At every turbulent time in the life of Joseph, he was always finding help from somebody.

For us to walk in Divine favor therefore, the first step is that we must belong to God through His One and only Son Jesus Christ and this is actualized through the New Birth experience, John 6:37, Romans 10:9-10.
